The successful candidate will be expected to teach the Veterinary Parasitology course by teaching lectures and laboratories. The successful candidate would be required to teach the course once per semester (three times per year) in person, which would require travel to Grand Cayman for 2-3 weeks at a time (once this is safely permitted with Covid).
