



W3 professorship for “Microbiology and epizootic diseases” (m/f/d)

at the Institute of Microbiology (in the Centre for Infection Medicine) beginning on the 1st of October 2024. Depending on the personal requirements, the appointment will be made as a civil servant or employee on the basis of the W3 grade. Depending on individual suitability and requirements, a temporary appointment may be considered initially.

Areas of responsibility:

The applicant is expected to represent the field of microbiology and epizootic diseases in its entire range of teaching, research and other services. This includes all aspects of general and special microbiology as well as animal disease control and infection epidemiology (the latter in collaboration with the Institute of Virology) including microbiological diagnostics.

The applicant is expected to develop innovative teaching and learning concepts and to demonstrate a knowledge of university didactics.

The research activity is to be centred in the area of pathogen-host interaction in bacterial infections and strengthen the research focus on “Infection Medicine” at the TiHo. This also includes the future-oriented use of replacement and complementary methods for animal experiments. We expect active, transdisciplinary cooperation with other scientific institutions within the Centre for Infection Medicine at TiHo and beyond, as well as – particularly in the context of externally funded research projects – at a national and international level.

Requirements:

An international research profile with several years of experience and proven scientific activities in the above-mentioned fields supported by excellent publications and third-party funding is expected.

Recruitment conditions are a veterinary licence to practice veterinary medicine in Germany, pedagogical aptitude and teaching experience, doctorate, habilitation or equivalent scientific achievements. Recognition as a veterinary specialist in microbiology or bacteriology and mycology is a prerequisite; recognition by the European or American College of Veterinary Microbiology (ECVM or ACVM) is desirable.

Experience with the successful acquisition of third-party funding as well as staff and business management is expected.

Existing evidence of courses in university didactics and the results of teaching evaluations should be submitted with the application. The other recruitment requirements are regulated in § 25 of the Lower Saxony Higher Education Act (NHG).

The University of Veterinary Medicine Hannover Foundation is endeavouring to increase the number of female professors. Women are, therefore, expressly requested to apply (§ 21 para. 3 NHG).

Severely disabled applicants will be given special consideration in the event of equal suitability.

Applications from scientists and researchers from abroad are expressly welcome. German language skills, both written and spoken, are expected, but can also be strengthened in the initial period.
